<p><i>Suggestions to Ensure a Problem Free Roof...</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Please Take Preventative Action Inside Your Home...</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Check, and/or remove paintings, antiques, photos, mirrors, etc. from walls, as these may incur damage if they fall due to the walls vibrating during roofing. ◆ If you have Satellite dishes that you still use please send me an email so I can note that they need to be put back up after install of your roof. You will also want to call your provider and schedule a calibration
<p><i>Landscaping And Shrub Protection Efforts...</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ If there are any special or delicate plants or shrubs, please notify us of them before the job starts and we will protect them as best as possible.
